What do you envision being in the park?

- Space for an art show, with art from people of different ages and ethnicity, change the display seasonally
 - o Can be an indoor winter activity
- Central space for a meeting
 - o Need a big pavilion, would like 200-500 people
 - Big spaces for classes (senior programing)
 - Usually use one in St. Paul at Long Lake or Golden Valley but would like one closer
 - Could be a bunch of smaller pavilions
 - o Discount rental for people from Northside
 - Art museum that provides place to showcase Northside arts. Hmong art exhibits along side East African etc. Programing and vendor foods for events support use of museum events and showcase cultural traditions. Rotating exhibits.
 - o Amphitheater for dance performances
 - Farmers market/food vendors
 - Event Center
